**A Resolution Adopting the Seal Rock Water District's Representation in the Updates
to the Lincoln County Oregon
Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan**

Whereas, the Seal Rock Water District (SRWD) recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people, property and infrastructure within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people, property and infrastructure from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, an adopted Lincoln County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre-and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, the Seal Rock Water District has fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare the *Lincoln County, Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan*, which has established a comprehensive, coordinated planning process to eliminate or minimize these vulnerabilities; and

Whereas, the Seal Rock Water District has identified natural hazard risks and prioritized a number of proposed actions including the development and installation of emergency inter-tie connections that benefit the region, along with programs that include the need to mitigate the vulnerabilities of the SRWD system to the impacts of future disasters within the *Lincoln County, Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan*; and


Whereas, these proposed projects and programs will be incorporated into the *Lincoln County, Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan* that has been prepared and promulgated for consideration and implementation by the SRWD, Lincoln County and the Cities of Lincoln County; and

Whereas, the Oregon Office of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region-10 officials have reviewed the *Lincoln County, Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan* and approved on October 21, 2015.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Seal Rock Water District adopts the *Lincoln County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan* as an official plan; and


Be it further resolved, that the Seal Rock Water District will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Oregon Office of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region-10 officials to enable approval of the District's inclusion in the *Lincoln County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan*.
